OUR IMPACT

Employment participation rate in Australia for people with disabilities. Unemployment is a major reason for poverty.



Unemployment in Hume City is 57.6%, higher than the Australian average. Poverty is major cause of housing stress and homelessness.



E-waste is one of the fastest growing types of waste. Zero waste strategies use less new raw materials and divert waste from landfill.



Cohesive communities create a sense of belonging. We create a platform for social inclusion to support and engage local disadvantaged community.



Delivered **34,767** hours of employability skills for **1,024** participants most likely to experience barriers to employment to improve job prospects. Social impact discount applied for disadvantaged community to access technology **\$8,400**

Created **12,062** hours of full award wage work and **16 Employment pathway outcomes**; 4 referrals to further training, 5 casual and 7 part-time employment outcomes through Enable's enterprise trade, supporting local disadvantaged and economic development across Melbourne's north.

Diverted **227,190** kgs of decommissioned assets from landfill for reuse and recycling. **209** items of Affordable Technology distributed to community in need. Toner recycling local collaboration laid **309km** of local road.

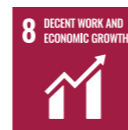
Enabled **13,779** hours of general public volunteering, supporting social inclusion and cohesive communities.
